Behavioural Skills

- a team player
- able to develop and maintain good working relationships
- able to juggle priorities
- able to get the important stuff done

Here is a trustworthy saying: If anyone sets his heart on being an overseer, he desires a noble task. Now the overseer must be above reproach, the husband of but one wife, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. He must manage his own family well and see that his children obey him with proper respect.

(If anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he take care of God's church?) He must not be a recent convert, or he may become conceited and fall under the same judgment as the devil. He must also have a good reputation with outsiders, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap.

It is a trustworthy statement: if any man aspires to the office <episkope> of overseer <episkope>, it is a fine work he desires to do. An overseer <episkopos>, then, must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, temperate, prudent, respectable, hospitable, able to teach...

Bible Fellowship Assembly:

Follow New Testament model

Plurality of elders (qualified men)

Teaching the gathered assembly (qualified men)

Elder Roles:

- Feed congregation, ensure ongoing public exposition of God's word
- Do work of a shepherd to lead by example
- Support the weak, and
- reprove, rebuke, and exhort as necessary
- ministry leaders responsible to the elders group

Application

elders - keep fire burning hot, ensure lives are consistent with God's calling

others - pray, share praise and prayer items with us (communication goes two ways)

Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith.
