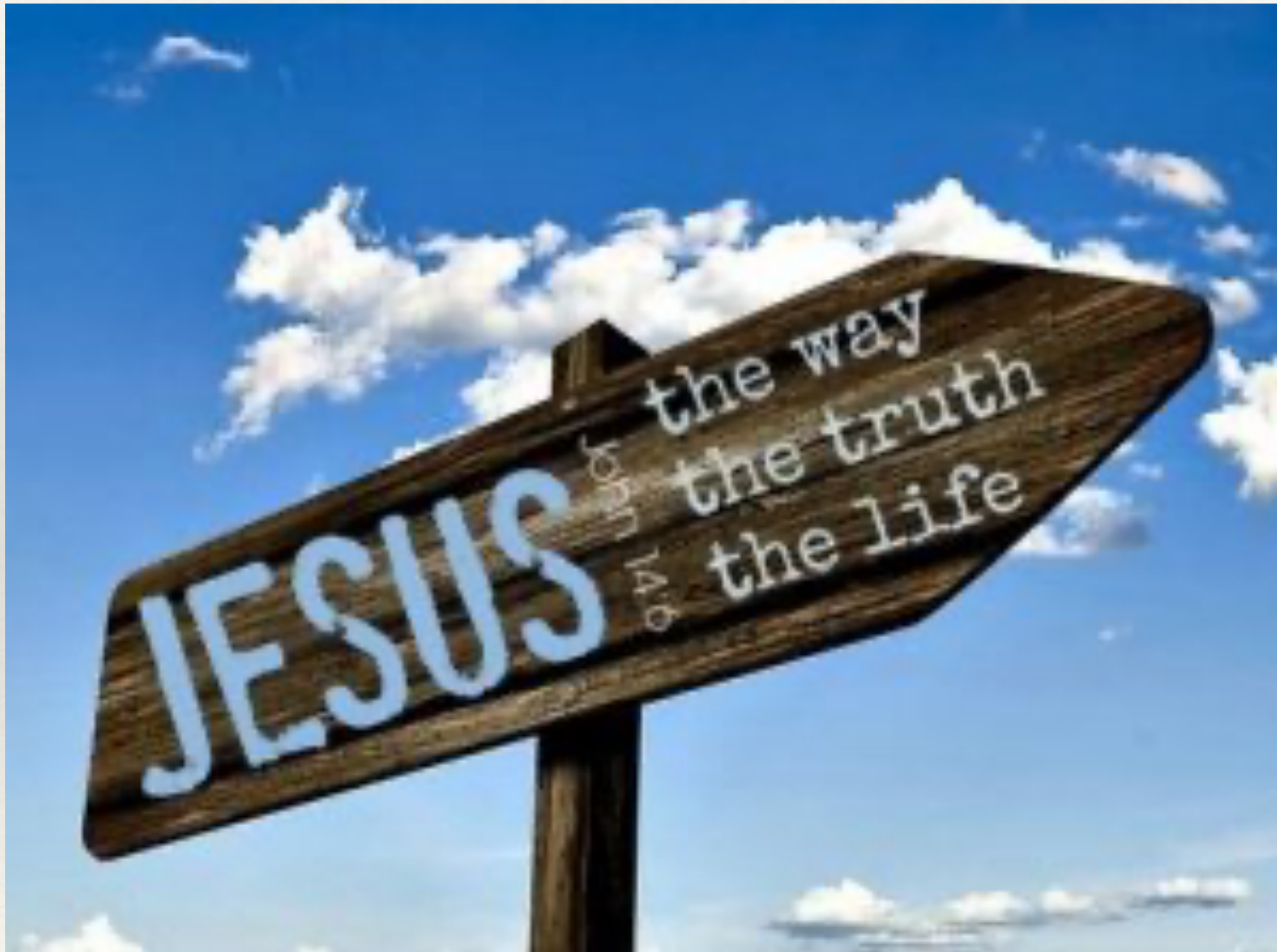
John 8:44 NLT
